South Kolkata's Favourite Now At Salt Lake

- Designed by renowned Art Director, Mr Nitish Roy
- Comes up with their second outlet at Saltlake after Deshapriya Park

Kolkata, 17th August, 2015: Oudh 1590, Kolkata's first period dining restaurant opened their second outlet at Salt Lake after conquering the heart of the discerning food lovers of Kolkata with its maiden outlet at Deshapriya Park in South Kolkata. This outlet will primarily cater to the food lovers of north Kolkata, Salt Lake, Sector 5 & Rajarhat as there were requests galore to open Oudh 1590 in the northern fringes of the city. Actress, **Ms Gargi Roy Chowdhury** was present to showcase the exotic range of Awadhi delicacies.

"We had received enormous request from the locals to open an outlet in Saltlake. For the past one year, me and my brother Debaditya had done extensive research and traveled to lucknow to learn more about the language, culture and most importantly the food habit of the Awadhi period. The architecture of this outlet is the result of our research. We are extremely confident that Oudh 1590 will win over the hearts of the people residing in this area just as it did in Deshapriya Park", said **Mr Shiladitya Chaudhury, Partner, Oudh 1590.**

Oudh 1590 at Salt Lake is an architectural marvel, recreating the essence of the old heritage of Lucknow or Awadh, as it was known then, in every corner. The murals, the floor tiles, the chandeliers, the dining table or the bronze plated crockery and cutlery resemble the grandeur of the era. This 72 seater restaurant located at CD 86, Sector 1, Salt Lake (behind city Centre 1) is designed by renowned Art Director, Mr Nitish Roy, who has won many accolades for his works in films like Ghayal, Lekin, Jo Jeeta Wohi Sikander, Kharij, Mandi, Tamas, Salaam Bombay, Parinda, Fanaa, Ak Poshla Brishti, etc.

"The response we received from our first outlet was overwhelming and this inspired us to serve authentic awadhi delicacy to the north eastern part of the city. Lot of people has asked us to open an outlet here, as it is difficult for them to travel all the way to Deshapriya Park. This is a gift to them", said **Mr Debaditya Chaudhury, Partner, Oudh 1590.**

The items in the menu are same as the ones available at the existing Oudh 1590, the highlights being **Galawati Kabab, Sheekh Kabab, Brain Masala, Nehari Khas, Rann Biriyani, Awadhi Handi Biriyani and Shahi Tukra.** New Kaarigars have been brought from Lucknow for this restaurant as well. The "Dum Pukht" style of cooking with aromatic ingredients, dried fruits and aphrodisiacs that delighted the insatiable Nawabs is being maintained in this restaurant too. A Meal for two will cost Rs 1000/- exclusive of taxes.

About Oudh 1590:

OU DH - 1590 is a humble initiative to introduce a true "period dining" experience recreated in today's kitchens to be savoured at the table. A research on the culture and cuisine of Awadh (modern day Lucknow) is a gift to Kolkata - the city of Gourmet a first of its kind PERIOD DINING experience. Bawarchis working extensively at TUNDE WALI GALLI at Lucknow have been roped in for this initiative. Located at the heart of South Kolkata next to Deshapriya Park (Opposite Carmel School) the 55 seater restaurant will boast a period look recreating a 16th century feel. The bronze plated crockery and cutlery has been tailor made for the eatery hoping that the cuisine of Oudh within the ambience of OUDH 1590 will be able to rekindle the romance of Shaam - E - Awadh.

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
