Located at the heart of South Kolkata next to Deshapriya Park (Opposite Carmel School), Vivekananda Park (off Southern Avenue) at CD 86, Sector 1, Salt Lake (behind city Centre 1) and 335 Jessore Road and at Naktala (Bunty Cinema Bus Stop) wherein the restaurants boast of a period look recreating the 16th century feel. The bronze plated crockery and cutlery has been tailor made for the eatery hoping that the cuisine of Oudh within the ambience of OUDH 1590 will be able to rekindle the romance of Shaam - E - Awadh.
