Workshop On Victim Compensation Held

Kolkata, 22nd March, 2022: The District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), Kolkata, recently conducted a workshop on *Victim Compensation*, which is one of the welfare schemes for the victims of human trafficking.

This was organised for 25 empanelled Legal Aid Lawyers and Para- Legal Volunteers (PLV) including some PLVs of West Bengal Legal Services Authority.

The dignitaries present were Shri. Raju Mukherjee, Learned Member Secretary, State Legal Services Authority (SLSA), West Bengal, Shri. The workshop was aimed to equip the legal-aid lawyers and para-legal volunteers as they play an important role in the implementation of various schemes and bridging the gap between the legal authorities and the victims.

"From the year 2016 to 2022, Victim Compensation scheme has made a compensation to total 587 victims with amount of Rs. 1,58,171,706 respectively," said **Shri. Sukumar Mondal, Learned Registrar-cum-Deputy Secretary, SLSA, West Bengal.**
